Request to authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to enter into a contract with Rosenbauer South Dakota (Vendor No. 3072941) to purchase a pumper truck for the Fire Department, for an amount not to exceed $\$ 583,189$. Further request authorization for the City Controller to disburse all funds related to this item.

The pumper truck is needed to provide emergency response services, including fire suppression, and swift water and technical rescues. The new pumper truck will replace unit No. 231331, which has reached the end of its useful life.

## Procurement Results

The equipment pricing was quoted from the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) agreement. The H-GAC is a regional council of governments operating under the laws of the State of Texas, and their agreements cover capital-intensive products and services, such as heavy equipment and emergency vehicles. The Houston-Galveston Area Council Cooperative Contract was awarded on December 1, 2015, and will end on November 30, 2017.

Financial Impact
The purchase shall not exceed $\$ 583,189$. Funds are available in the Fire Department's budget.
